# 3. Entry Fee and payment

The Entry fee for this Championship is set as the following:

F3A pilots: NOK 3500
Nordic pilots: NOK 3500
Banquet: NOK 600

The entry fee includes 1 ticket for the banquet.

**F3A judges:** "Non-flying" judges are covered for accommodation and lunch including the banquet. Settlement is organized afterwards via sent receipts and travel bills. Pilots who judge class F3A will have lunch expenses covered.

**Lunch** will be served at the airport and is settled by the individual on the spot. Card terminal will be available.

### 9. Additional Information

- IMPORTANT!!! National flag and national anthem:

  We ask all team managers to bring their own country's flag (balcony flag type) and their country's national anthem in mp3 format on a memory stick.
- **Parking:** This year's Nordic championships take place in an active agricultural area. This means that we have to be considerate when we drive through the farms and when we park our cars. We must park in a way that does not in any way block the way for the farmers and their machines.
- **Speed limit:** The speed limit is 30 km/h on the gravel road through the farms.
- Toilet: An outhouse/toilet is available approximately 50 meters from the airstrip.
